2017 ANNUAL BUDGET

The Board of Directors has undertaken a thorough review of the operating budget for the 2017 fiscal year with the goal of providing for efficient operations and for funding adequate reserves to meet long-term requirements. As a result of this review, the Board has determined that assessments will increase \$10.00 per month for the upcoming fiscal year, making the new monthly assessment \$150.00 per month, effective January 1, 2017. The increase is the result of needing to be fiscally prudent, planning for adequate funding for the Reserve street repairs project scheduled for 2018, and in anticipation of minor wage increase pass-throughs by vendors.

For homeowners who are enrolled in the ACH program for monthly withdrawal of assessments from their checking or savings account, the monthly assessment will automatically be increased to the new assessment amount, effective January 1, 2017. However, for homeowners who subscribe to bill pay with their own banks, they will have to instruct their bank to change the amount for the monthly assessment payment from \$140.00 to \$150.00 per month. FIREPLACE SAFETY TIPS FOR THE WINTER
