- Jim Bradley will follow up with the South Coast Water District to resolve the French drains on Saint John and will ask Ed Perez of LaBelle-Marvin to look at the red stamped concrete ribbons from the cul-de-sac on Saint John to Dominica and from Dominica to Saint Anne.
- Approved the proposal for \$851.00 for miscellaneous landscape items discussed during the October landscape
 walk from Grant's Landscape Services, with the change from mixed colored Snapdragon flowers to red and
 white Cyclamen to be installed after November 9, 2018,
