PRE-EMPTIVE BOARD APPROVAL FOR STAINING DRIVEWAYS

During the September 28, 2021 Board Zoom meeting, the Board agreed to the pre-emptive Board approval for appeal for staining driveways using the authorized stain and sealer from Classic Coatings for a period of one year. To summarize, the Board is allowing homeowners to have their driveways stained with the authorized stain and sealer without having to submit an architectural application to the Architectural Committee, for a period of year, if the approved products and the process for the stain and sealer are used and followed, in order to encourage and make it easier for homeowners to stain their driveways.

The red stained concrete repairs of the circle at the Saint Michael cul-desac have been completed by Concrete Doctor. If you would like to have your driveways stained by Concrete Doctor, please send an email Rosmen Paguio, Community Association Manager, at rpaguio@keystonepacific.com, and she will forward the list to Trace Davis of Concrete Doctors who will be able to provide a group discount for a group of 10 homeowners. Homeowners will be responsible for completing the homeowner/vendor agreement and paying Trace directly for their driveway staining. Trace can be reached on his cell phone at (949) 842-3583.

Homeowners also have the option to have their driveways stained using the approved products and process by a general contractor of their own choosing.
